Will 5G improve mobile coverage in Norway?

The new 5G network will provide better mobile coverage and gradually better access to broadband across the country, which will reduce the vulnerability of an increasingly digitised society," said Linda Hofstad Helleland. In March 2020, Telenor became the first Norwegian mobile operator to offer 5G connectivity to customers.

Can a 5G base station be flown by a drone?

No one company owns 5G. It is planned and managed by the 3rd Generation Partnership Project (3GPP), a consortium of companies and organisations including infrastructure suppliers, device manufacturers, mobile network operators and vertical service providers.
