1Andrew Silverman, You say "I have shown" when the timeframe is in the past but indefinite in nature, not referring to a specific event. You say "I showed (something) to ...

Is the phrase "is shown" a passive structure? This is my example: The global trade in wild products and the purchase of kangaroo products outside Australia is shown to create ...

The past participle shown was uncommon before the 19th century, but is now the preferred form in standard English. In the UK, showed is regarded as archaic or dialectal.

I need advice on the best use of the verb show. When do you use showed? I find myself substituting has shown, even when I meant to use the preterit in my sentence. I prefer ...

Shown is used here in the sense of having been demonstrated, explained, proven, or confirmed. It was shown... [simple past tense or indicative preterite] It has been shown...
