Will US troops stay in Iraq in 2025?

Timothy VanDusen) BEIRUT -- The US formally announced today that the coalition mission in Iraq will come to a close in September 2025, but emphasized that troops will stay in country as part of an "evolution of the military mission in Iraq" and the counter-ISIS mission will continue.

How many US military bases are in Iraq?

When does the coalition military mission in Iraq end?

"In the first phase, the coalition's military mission in Iraq will end. This means coalition forces will withdraw from certain locations in Iraq as mutually determined. The transition period in Iraq begins now and will end in September 2025," the DOD stated in its announcement of the plan.
