Does China invest in Angola?

Angola represents the second largest destination for Chinese foreign investment, with Chinese firms investing approximately \$12 billion in the country over the past decade. Covering various sectors of the economy, Chinese investment has served as a linchpin for project development in Angola.

Does China have a stake in Angola?

In Angola, Chinese companies have stakes in various diamond, copper and gold mines. Chinese mining company Sinomine signed an offtake agreement in June 2023 for the Namibe Lithium project in Angola. Sinomine is investing \$21.3 to support exploration and development activities at the project.

China's telecommunications sector is valued at \$491.9 billion and is projected to reach \$562.3 billion by 2029. As such, Angola's Ministry of Telecommunications, Information Technologies and Social Communication is strengthening ties with China to modernize the country's telecommunications industry.
